TAX CLEARANCE LETTER REQUEST FOR REINSTATEMENT

In order to reinstate an entity, the Secretary of State requires evidence that the entity is eligible to reinstate with regard to franchise tax requirements. To provide this evidence, the Comptroller's office issues a Tax Clearance Letter, Form 05-377. This letter must be included as part of the reinstatement filing with the Texas Secretary of State.
